

CRUISING CHECKLIST

- Drinking water bottles (large and small)
- Thermos (large and small), drink (hot or cold)
- Tea, coffee, sugar, milk powder
- Breakfast cereal, meat, (sausages), baked beans, tinned soup, spaghetti, eggs, can opener.
- Esky, butter, fresh milk/So Good, cooler bricks, bread, spread
- Meusli bars, nibblies
- Plates, breakfast dishes, cups, cutlery, pots, frying pan, tea billy
- Tea towel, detergent, washbowl
- Plastic bag for rubbish. Bag for dirty clothes
- Sunscreen, mosquito repellent
- Shaver (12V lead and charged), towel, soap, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrush
- CCYA burgee, tee-shirt, jersey, cap
- Shorts, swimmers, jeans, underwear, shoes, socks, shirts warm clothes, wet weather gear, thongs, sandals.
- Sleeping bag, pillow
- Reading material, glasses, camera
- Barbeque, BBQ plate, gas, chairs
- Life jackets, knife, headsail bag, paddle, whisker pole, marine radio aerial
- Rudder, tiller, cockpit cushions, companionway cover, boom awning, hatch prop
- Fluoro light, torch (spare battery, bulb), tool box (x2), first aid kit (x2), maps, tide charts, shackle key, insulation tape, safety checklist
- Charge the battery. Solar panel, mast-head light, battery condition monitor.
- Marine radio, AM/FM radio, mobile phone, phone 12V charger lead.
- Porta Potty chemicals, toilet paper
- Petrol, oil (mixed and/or separate), fuel tank(s), fuel hose, funnel, outboard motor, tools, spark plug, WD40
- Trailer spare wheel bearing, spare tyre, winch handle, skids spanner, jockey wheel, car toolbox, WD40 (in car to service the trailer)
- Check and grease the trailer
- Secure the boat to the trailer before leaving and hose clean, if required
- Weather forecast

Careel - Boat, Car and Trailer Check-off List

Car

- Check fuel, oil and water
- Check tyres and spare tyre
- Check suspension and towbar
- Check car jack and tools in boot
- External extended mirrors fitted (if required)
- Auto repair light (in car or boat)
- Mobile phone or CB radio in car

Trailer & Boat

- Check tyres and spare tyre
- Check all trailer lights
- Connect boat electric fridge to car (if required)
- Ensure bow of boat secured to trailer with safety chain
- Portable air compressor in car
- Place jockey wheel in car
- Release trailer hand brake (if fitted)
- Release override reverse lockout clip
- Ensure chain and electric cable attached to car
- Place wood jacking blocks in car
- Attach boat tie down
- Ensure boarding ladder secured up
- Ensure rudder is secure
- Spare spark plugs, propeller, shear pin and split pin for outboard motor
- Ensure boat battery fully charged
- Check mast is secured to boat
- Check stays/shrouds and spreaders are secure and not touching the boat

- Check radio aerials are flexible and secured
- Check navigation lights
- Check emergency battery operated navigation lights
- Check halyards and other lines neatly stowed or secured
- Check for no loose objects in cabin or cockpit
- Check the water tank is full if water unavailable at destination
- Check emergency water containers
- Check and secure solar panel (if fitted)
